Students are provided afternoon refreshment every day from Skólamatur.

Skólasel is closed during Christmas and Easter vacation and on teacher conference days. On parent communication days Skólasel provides services from 8:15 - 16:00On extracurricular days Skólasel usually opens as soon as programs end, those days are notified especially on each occasion.

Parents expenses:

The service is required to be paid in advance, Suðurnesjabær town board oversees the charges. If payments have not been received two weeks after their due date the student cannot continue to make use of the service at Skólasel. Full fee is 14.250 kr. per month/with afternoon refreshment Half fee is 8.900kr. per month/with afternoon refreshment Half fee is 6 hours of afterschool service per week. There is a 30% sibling discount off service fees per second child using the service and 100% discount off service fees by the third sibling. Single parents get 25% discount off service fees.

Skólasel uses the Karellen registration system. There, parents can file there child's attendance and see photos from the work at Skólasel.



In Skólasel there is an organized program for free play, arts, exercise and nutrition. The staff of Sandgerðisskóli is working by the ideology of the Reconstruction Policy. (e.Restitoution)

In the selection program, there are a number of options available, such as coloring, playing, puzzling, clay work, outdoor activities, briquettes, pearls and pleasure reading.

Once a week, students go to the library, the computer room and to the gym to have fun.

Skólasel requires two weeks' notice for new children to arrive and for children to discontinue the service.
